

ANZAC DAY PROMOTION
WIN \$10,000 – TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter forms part of the Terms and Conditions of entry. By acknowledging the terms and conditions check box, all entrants hereby accept these terms and conditions. By entering the competition, participants are automatically subscribed to receive all marketing from The Promoter.
 2. The promotion commences at 08.00am EDST on 10 December 2017 and ends at 8.00pm on AEST 23 April 2018 (**Promotional Period**).
 3. All entrants must be Australian residents only aged eighteen (18) years or over (**Eligible Entrant**).
